- Locates resources that support the learning process

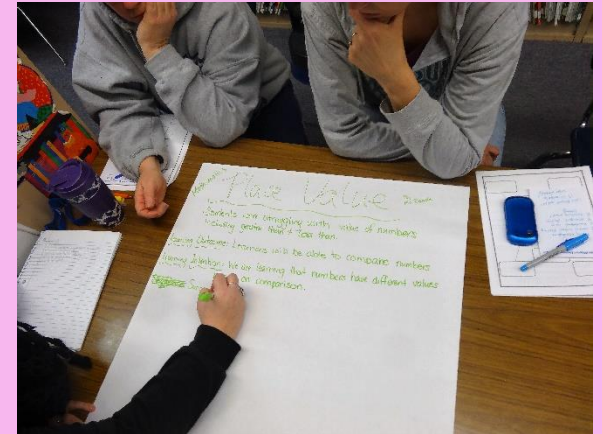
## Why work with an instructional coach?

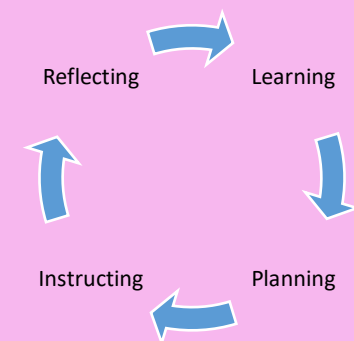

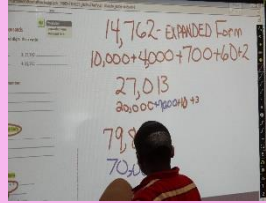

## What does a coaching cycle look like?

1. Preconference
2. Observation
3. Analyze Data
4. Post Conference

The first phase of a coaching cycle is pre-conferencing and setting a goal. Once the preconference is completed, the teacher and coach will participate in classroom observations. Then we will meet again to analyze the data, have a planning session and a post-conference to determine if we met the initial goal.
